## **RULES:**

Teams will consist of only 4 members. Each of the 4 members will be able to help build the boat. No outside boat building allowed. All boats will be built on site on Saturday, June 22nd starting at 3:00.

- 1. One of the 4 members of the team will be chosen by the team to captain the boat.
- 2. Cost is \$10 per team. Each team will receive 1 piece of cardboard, 1 utility knife and 1 roll of duct tape. (One additional role of tape can be purchased that day for \$10 each) Each team will have 1 1/2 hours to build their boat and will make their oar out of their sheet of card board.
- 3. Each team will be required to name their boat, a marker will be available to use at the check-in table.
- 4. All teams must have atleast one member that is over 18 years old.
- 5. All teams must supply themselves with a life jacket for their boat captain.
- 6. Boats will be judged by the following categories. "Best Built Boat" "1st Place Winner" (boat that wins the final heat) "The Titanic" (first boat to sink). Bay-Rama will judge these categories.
- 7. Only limited amount teams will accepted to participate. Number will be determined by available cardboard. The goal is to have 25 teams.
- 8. Each team member must sign a release form to participate.
- 9. Boat building will end promptly at 4:30 & Races begin. Racers will have to run the short course and then head back to shore.
- 10. Races will run in heats of 5, order of races will be determined on site the day of the race. The first boat to finish each heat, will then go on to the final heat. The winner of the final heat will be the 1st place winner.
- 11. This is a family friendly event so please HAVE FUN!! (In the event of inclement weather, the race will be cancelled, no refunds will be given)
